Ephesians 2:8-10 King James Version (KJV)

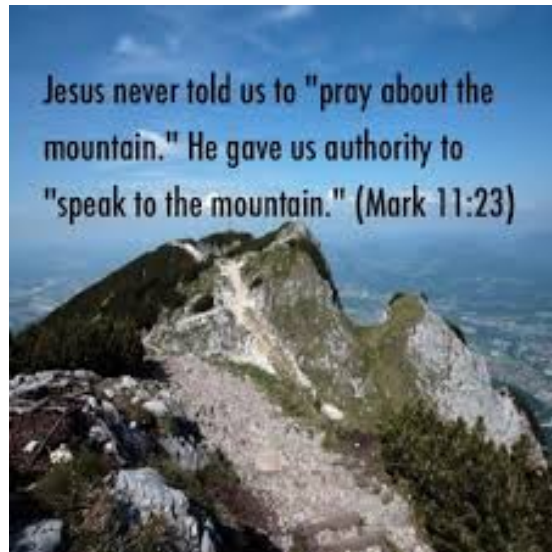
8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
